District 10 Report

Dennis N. reported on District 10 meeting. Jeff H. created a report for the district showing the very large percentage of contributions attributable to a single group – S. Leawood. The report compared the monthly percentage of contributions by the S. Leawood group and all other groups combined over a two year period. The percentage given to the district by S. Leawood ranged from 40% to 73%, with an approximate average of 50%.

District 10 has a prudent reserve of \$1,000 but currently has a balance of over \$3,000.

Dennis gave the District 10 corrections report. AJ discussed corrections volunteer opportunities. These are posted on the bulletin board.

Officers Reports

Treasurer's Report – Chris H. distributed and reviewed the treasurer's report and the group approved the report.

Corrections Report – nothing to add from above.

Literature – Mike M. reported we're low on Big Books and 12x12's but Central Office was out of both when he went by. Chris will order more meeting schedule cards and yellow deposit envelopes. Jeff H. pointed out we need more newcomer's packets.

Treatment – no report, Michelle resigned so Chris will take her place and Tracey will be alternate.

CPC (Cooperation with Professional Communities) – Jennifer B. is looking for volunteers to address mailings to doctors and lawyers in Johnson County. She discussed programs designed to educate student nurses at JCCC and ER directors and to man a booth at a convention being held by nurse educators at the five local hospitals.

Central Office – Dennis M. gave the Central Office report. The proposal to have a central location for monthly meetings was nixed and CO will continue to sell 24 hour books, in spite of some controversy.

PI (Public Information) – Dan M. reported that our ad was now running in the Sun and BB's have been distributed to the high schools. Next year we will target high school health classes and Dan discussed efforts to contact radio station program directors about devoting Public Service Announcement time to AA topics. Dan asked for volunteers to call program directors – see Dan for more information.

Old Business

Discussion continued on the suggestion Jeff T. made a few months ago to supply BB's to JoCo Community Corrections. Dennis N. reported that the center has books but subsequent discussion raised the possibility that the books are not accessible 24 hours. Apparently we need to try to get the books into the so called "pods". Dennis will pursue this further.

New Business

Jeff T. initiated discussion on how to spend District 10 excess money. Some of the ideas discussed are listed below:

- 24 hour round robin
