GSR Report

Frank (South Leawood GSR) reported on the District 10 meeting. The district proposed an amendment to their bylaws dealing with maintaining a prudent literature reserve as suggested by the GSO but at the same time limiting inventory to a reasonable level.

The district's Corrections chairman, Pat McNolte, is compiling a list of who is taking what meetings to which correctional institutions.

The district's Treatment chairman, Lisa Lillard, is compiling a list of who is taking what meetings to which treatment centers.

Dan M. distributed the agenda for the upcoming Area 25 meeting.

Given the large number of attendees, a number of which were first timers, Kevin and Frank spent a few minutes explaining a little about how the business meetings work and where S. Leawood fits into the AA organization.

Officers Reports

Treasurer's Report (Chris H) – Chris H. distributed and reviewed the treasurer's report and the group approved the report. Chris spent a little time explaining the group's expenditures, including the prudent reserve level of \$600 and the percentages used in donations to the area, district, central office, and GSO organizations.

Corrections Report (Dennis N) – The district's Corrections chairman, Pat McNolte, is compiling a list of who is taking what meetings to which correctional institutions. Dennis stated the three prerequisites for taking meetings into correctional facilities:

1. must have one year "off paper"
2. must complete training program

3. must be sober at least one year

Literature (Mike M) – No report.

Treatment (Chris H) – Chris reported that letters containing AA contact information and offering to bring meetings are being prepared for nursing professionals and nursing homes. The district's Treatment chairman, Lisa Lillard, is compiling a list of who is taking what meetings to which treatment centers.

Cooperation with Professional Communities (Jennifer B) – Looking for volunteers to carry the message to student nurses. Cards containing AA contact information such as central office phone number are being prepared and volunteers are needed to help with this activity.

Central Office (Dennis M) – No report.

Public Information (Angela) – Plans are being made to put literature racks in libraries and emergency rooms.

Old Business

Following a lively discussion, the group voted to allow children in meetings. The church will provide a separate room with toys that can be used when appropriate. Members were encouraged to use good judgment when bringing children and to avoid disrupting meetings.

A motion was made to keep group conscious decisions, as with the children issue, for a minimum period of six months. The motion passed.
